
## BAMBURGH BEACH WALK

Northumberland







Take a stroll along Northumberland's stunning coastline on our Bamburgh Beach Walk.

This accessible walk offers a snapshot of Bamburgh's rich heritage and picturesque scenery.

Starting at Bamburgh Lighthouse, you'll pass the locally known Rubiks cube pillboxes – which are actually World War II anti-tank concrete blocks painted as Rubiks cubes – before continuing onto Bamburgh windmill and Castle. There's so much to explore.
